

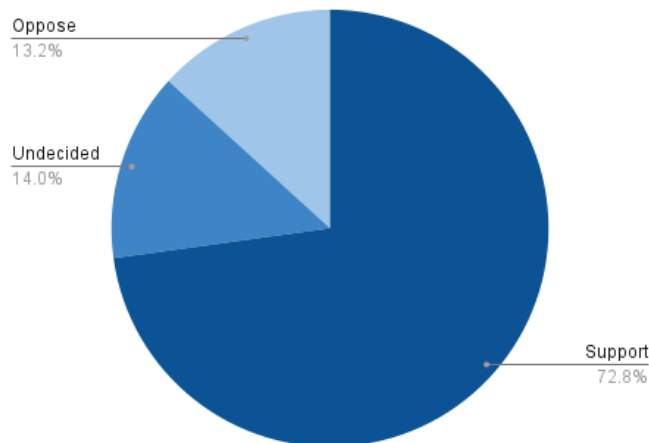
# Poll: Mainers want Restrictions on Ghost Guns

## Overview

New poll shows broad support among Mainers for the Maine legislature to pass laws requiring serialization of all firearms to address the growing problem of ghost guns. The poll was conducted among 831 registered Maine voters by Pan Atlantic Research and released in April 2025. A strong majority of Mainers across the state want the legislature to pass common sense firearm safety legislation. Even among Republicans, gun owners, and the most conservative districts, support for these gun safety measures is, at minimum 60%, and in most cases considerably higher.

## Poll Results

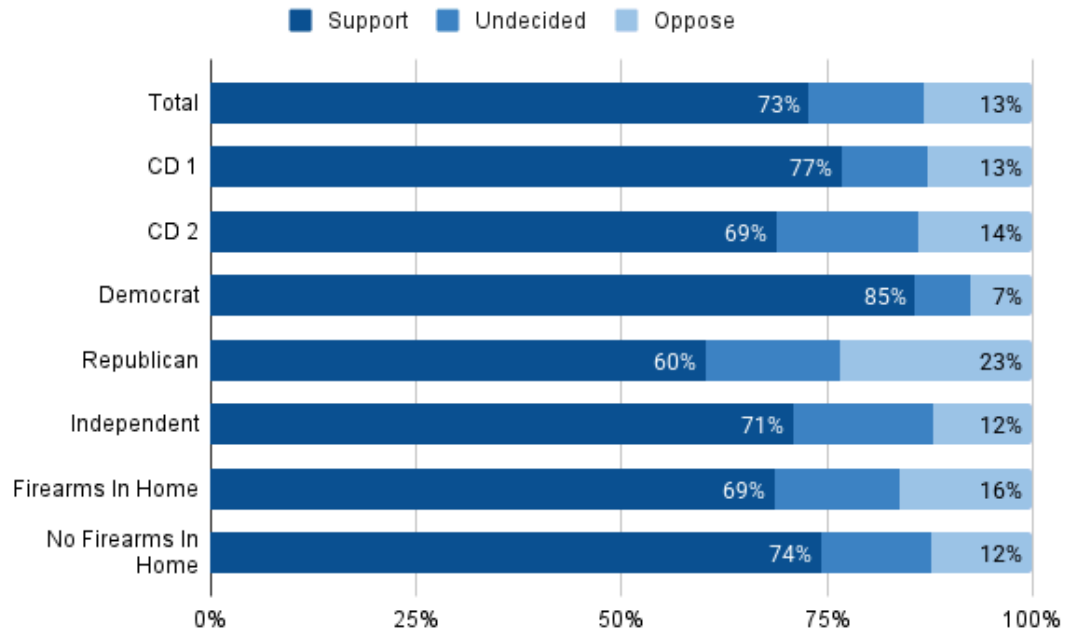
Ghost Guns - Poll: Maine (All)

**Mainers Undecided: 14%**

**Question:** *There is a proposal in the Maine legislature that would ban the possession, manufacture, and sale of untraceable firearms made from build-at-home kits or using 3D printers. These firearms, known as 'ghost guns,' lack serial numbers and can be obtained without a background check. Based on what you know, would you support or oppose such legislation?*

## Poll Results by Regions in Maine:

The same poll shows that support for a law addressing the growing problem of ghost guns is supported by 5 times as many Mainers as opposed. In all regions of the state, supporters of this law outnumber individuals opposed by at least 4 to 1.
